Introduction to Western or English Dressage

This is a full day clinic where participants will be divided into two groups and will ride once in the morning and again in the afternoon.

Morning Session - working on:

- Rhythm Regularity and Tempo
- Suppleness
- Contact connection and working over the back into softness
- Acceptance of aids

Participants will also work through exercises and transitions suited to individual horse and rider pairs.

<u>Afternoon Session</u> will provide an opportunity to ride a Western or English Dressage test pattern. This test will be called out for you as you ride the pattern. No need to memorize.

Noon hour lunch and learn will be an opportunity to discuss the scale of training and how Dressage training can improve any horse. There will be a hand out for you on some of the basic patterns dressage riders work toward riding. Q and A discussion will be open and welcoming. Please pack your own lunch, snacks, and beverages.

In order for riders to gain the best experience, groups will be arranged based on rider level. Basics of dressage remain the same no matter which style (English, western) saddle you choose to ride in.


