- miniature figurines & items for tea cup fairy gardens and FIND IT Jars (birds, sport themed, farm animals, fish, dinosaurs, etc.)
- plastic eggs (for the dinosaur eggs)
- wooden spoons
- kids gloves & hats (NHL colors)
- jewelry supplies (gorgeous beads!)
- horse shoes
