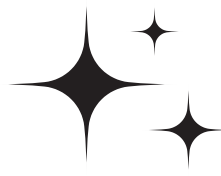

# LLAMAS



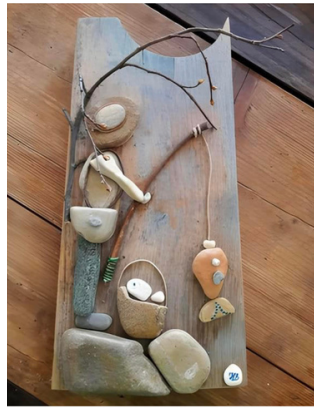
Patty taught us how to make the skeletons for the llamas & Unicorns at the volunteer luncheon day. Great production day!
