MRAS is offering a clinic for riders interested in Working Equitation Ease of Handling (EOH) Obstacles. Whether you are completely new to the sport, want to improve your skills or would like to participate in preparation for an upcoming show or event. Riders are welcome in any style of tack, English or Western.

Kimberly Cox has an accomplished background in Classical Dressage: riding, coaching, and judging. She is also a Working Equitation Judge. Kim will provide instruction, guidance, and support to the participants to ride the course of obstacles correctly, with confidence, and receive feedback to glean extra points at your next show. There may be a concentration on some of the more technical obstacles within the course.

Four (4) riders per group for each two (2) hour session.

- (A) No Working Equitation Experience / New to the sport
- (B) Working Equitation Experience
- (C) Experience and looking for Show Prep feedback

Clinic format:

- 1) Course walk (without horse); execution instruction provided
- 2) Practice time on the obstacles; more guidance given, as needed and requested
- 3) Each rider will have a turn to ride the EOH Course
- 4) (Time permitting) Speed Trial
